

*SAGTIKOS MANOR is the oldest house in the Town of Islip. Its earliest part was built in 1697 by Stephanus Van Cortlandt, the first native born mayor of New York City. In 1790 President George Washington spent the night here. The 42 room Manor and remaining 10 acres are currently owned by Suffolk County. The history of this house mirrors the history of Long Island and New York State.*

## MISSION

The Sagtikos Manor Historical Society was founded in 1963 by Islip Town Historian George L. Weeks, Jr. and a small group interested in preserving the rich history of a growing and changing suburban area. The society is chartered by the Educational Department of the University of the State of New York. The charter states the intent and purposes of the Sagtikos Manor Historical Society:

- To preserve and work for the preservation of historical buildings and landmarks in Suffolk County, New York, and to acquire, own and maintain one or more such landmarks and historical building, to maintain a museum and exhibit therein letters and other written materials and artifacts of historical interest.
- To promote and encourage historical research; to foster and promote public knowledge of and interest in local natural history.
